A Report On Webinar Arranged by Government Of Maharashtra

On July 25, 2024, the Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra, organized a webinar from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The Honorable Minister of Technical Education, Mr. Chandrakant Patil, interacted with students on the topics of tuition fee and examination fee exemptions for girls. He also discussed various scholarships and welfare schemes implemented by the Government of Maharashtra.

A total of 300 students from our institute attended the webinar, which proved to be highly informative. The session addressed many of the students' concerns and clarified doubts regarding the available exemptions and welfare schemes. The Honorable Minister highlighted that only 36% of female students pursue education compared to 64% of male students. To increase the percentage of girls in education, the government is implementing various schemes, including tuition fee and examination fee exemptions for girls.

A total of 6,000 institutes from all over Maharashtra participated in this webinar. Students from across the state asked numerous questions to the Honorable Minister, who clarified their doubts satisfactorily. The Honorable Minister also encouraged institutes to appoint a nodal officer for the effective implementation of these schemes. Additionally, he urged students to form committees of four to five members to ensure that all questions regarding these schemes are addressed.

Overall, the webinar was successful and marked a significant step towards increasing the percentage of girls pursuing education and implementation of various schemes for student welfare.
