Sub: Approval to the Tatyasaheb Kore Institute of Engineering & Technology, Warananagar, Kolhapur, Maharashtra for conducting degree courses in Engineering.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee which visited the Institute on 28.11.90, the recommendations made by the Western Regional Committee (WRC) at its Second Meeting held on 25.2.91 and the re-assessment made by an Expert Committee through visit on 1.2.92, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to Tatyasaheb Kore Institute of Engineering & Technology at Warananagar, Kolhapur, Maharashtra for conducting the following degree courses during the academic year 1992-93 only:

| S.No. | Name of the Course | Intake |
|-------|-------------------------|-----------|
| (1) | Civil Engineering | 60(Sixty) |
| (2) | Chemical Engineering | 60(Sixty) |
| (3) | Electronics Engineering | 60(Sixty) |

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The above approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. For an intake of 180 students, total 72 teaching staff are required in the ratio 1:2:4 (Professor : Asst. Professor : Lecturer). The deficiencies in the teaching staff shall be removed by the College within 2 years.
2. The required technical supporting staff shall be recruited to come at par with the AICTE norms.

3. No new course shall be started in the Institute without the prior approval of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).
4. The intake in any year in any of the AICTE approved courses shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
5. The Management including the Governing Council of the Institute shall be constituted as per the AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per AICTE guidelines.
6. The infrastructural and other facilities including equipment, faculty etc. shall be provided as recommended by the Expert Committee which visited the Institute on February 1, 1992 and also as per the AICTE norms and standards.
7. Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
8. The tuition and other fees should be as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
9. The teaching staff should be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.
10. The accounts of the Institute shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
11. The Institute shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Society or the Institute with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take measures for the closure of the programme and withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to closure would be that of the Society and/or the Institute.


