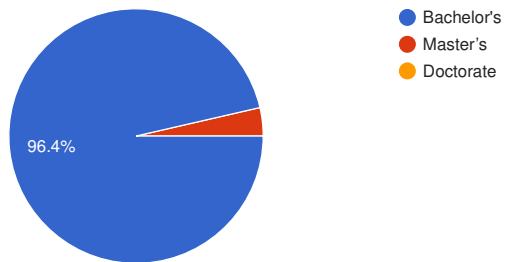
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

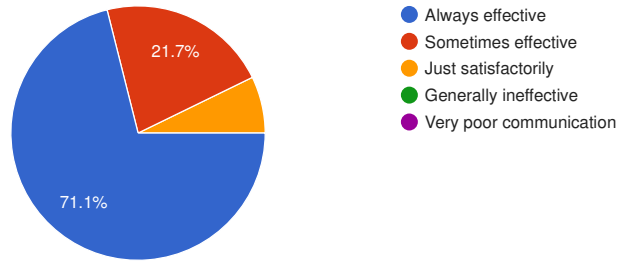

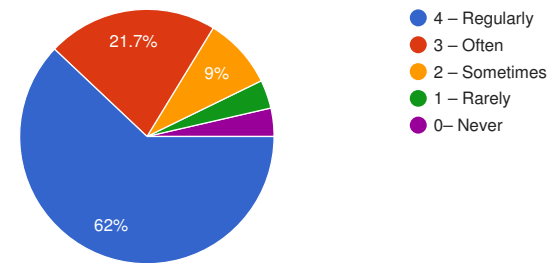

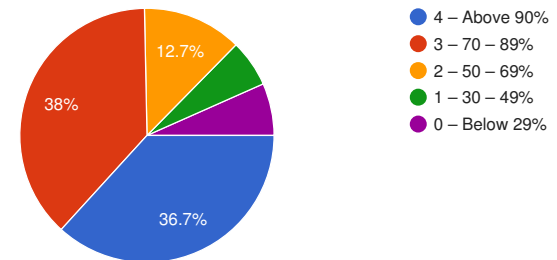

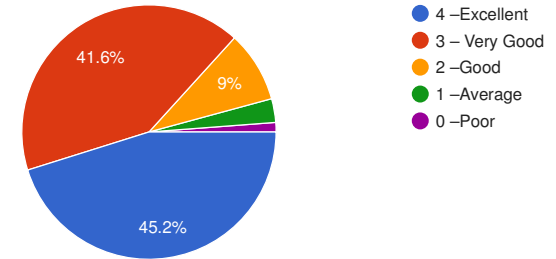

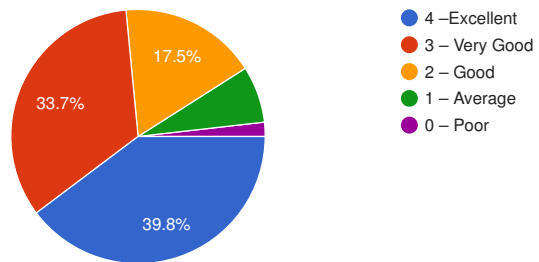

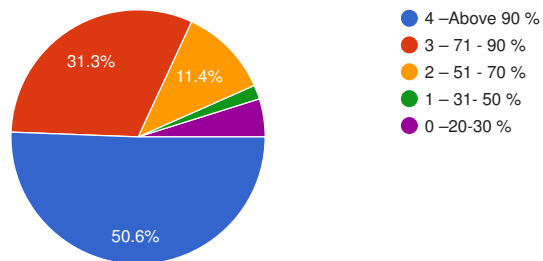

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Justification regarding the suggestions received from ----

- As the suggestions received from the student 2020-21, this batch completed their UG degree under the CBCS pattern affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur.
