Regulations and norms for recognition as a P.G. Teacher/ Guide in TKIET, Warananagar.

The basic qualification as a P.G. teacher is Master's Degree in the relevant subject/relevant branch (The master's degree must be of a Statutory Indian Universities or recognized Foreign Universities)

Following conditions shall be fulfilled for seeking recognition as a Post Graduate Teachers (for Master's Degree) :

a) A full time approved regular faculty in the institute with. M. E/ M. Tech or Ph. D Degree of a Statutory Indian Universities or recognized Foreign Universities.

AND

b) At least five years of approved teaching experience at U.G. level.

AND

c) Three years full time approved experience of teaching for final year B.E or B. Tech Classes.

OR

I) A person working in the recognized Research / Professional / Organization having Ph. D./ M. E. /M. Tech. with five years of research / industrial experience.

Rules other than minimum qualifications

- 1. Those faculty appointed for post graduate programme in the institute will be recognized as post graduate faculty, provided they will fulfill minimum required qualification for teaching post graduate programme as prescribed by respective apex bodies.
- 2. A recognized Post-Graduate faculty of any recognized University who is already retired may be allowed to work in the honorary capacity to teach or guide Post-Graduate students (Master Degree) up to the age of 65 years.
- 3. PG Recognition will be granted to a full time regular faculty till he / she is working in the Institute.
- 4. In case of the inadequate number of P.G. faculty in any subject in the Institute, other faculty may be considered for recognition as a special case for P. G. programmes.
